It is built on sand, which means we remain open when many other golf courses are closed due to wet weather. At 6600 yards the course offers a varied and challenging par of 72.

18-30's

This category of membership was introduced at Bletchingley in 2009. In recent years it has become increasingly apparent that at this stage of a young adult's life financial commitments and young families take priority over golf membership.

Our aim at Bletchingley is to make golf membership more affordable and to provide first class facilities, set in a relaxed environment overlooking the North Downs. With 18–30's Membership this will be available to you seven days a week and will cost you as little as £7.00 per week. We feel this is value for money and as a member you will have the opportunity to take advantage of the benefits that are listed below.

Flexible

This category of 'points' membership is designed for the golfer who does not play enough golf to justify subscribing to a 5 or 7 day membership but still wants to feel part of a golf club and benefit from the advantages membership can bring.

- Eligible to play in midweek and club stableford competitions Please note that members wishing to take advantage of this benefit are required to pay Annual Golf Union Fees in March each year in addition to the initial cost and any subsequent top ups. - Discounted food and beverage prices via 'Gold Card'
- Guests will be charged at member's flexible points rates
- Eligible to attend club social functions

Annual renewal is not applicable to this membership category. However, it should be noted that for membership to remain active, a minimum balance of 50 points must be maintained throughout the year. Any unused credits simply roll over.

If at any time a flexible member does not want to continue their membership they must inform the Club and surrender their gold card.

You will have access to play our fantastic 18 hole golf course and competitions will be arranged so you can meet and play with people of a similar standard.

The Initiate Membership is available for one year and a second year will be at the discretion of Wiseville & Co. Upgrading to the main membership categories will be available once the Professional has confirmed the required playing standard has been achieved. Benefits include:

When playing on the course, the Academy Member will need to be accompanied by an older junior or playing adult. Academy Members will have the option of starting each hole from the 150 yard marker, so they are not overpowered by the full length of the course, thus making the game of golf as enjoyable as possible.

Group lessons will be available to all Junior Academy Members on a monthly basis with our resident PGA Professional to enhance their progress.

The course will be available to play from 3:00pm in the Summer and 1:00pm in the Winter, seven days a week.

Equal Opportunities

In keeping with today's modern society, we offer equal opportunities to men, women and children. At the same time we maintain our traditional thriving Men's, Ladies, Business Ladies, Seniors and Juniors Sections, with their many organised golfing competitions and social events. Men and women can both compete in all the stableford, major trophy and team competitions throughout the year. Seven-day category members are encouraged to meet new people by playing in the regular swindles on Saturday and Sunday mornings. During the week we have very active Seniors and Ladies Sections but if you do not fit into either of these categories we also have an over 50's group who play on Wednesday mornings. Midweek medals and stablefords are held on the first and third Wednesday of each month.

Dress Code

A reasonable standard of dress is required on the course and in the Clubhouse at all times.

Smart/casual and formal wear is acceptable throughout the Clubhouse and hats/caps are to be taken off upon entry. Golf shoes must be worn on the golf course and are allowed in the Grand Slam Bar and other Clubhouse areas but are **NOT** allowed in the Main Bar and Restaurant. Shorts must be tailored and worn with knee length or white sport socks. All shirts should have collars and men's shirts should be tucked in at all times.

Please refrain from wearing Denim Jeans, 3/4 Length Shorts, Singlets, T-Shirts, Trainers, Track or Leisure Suits on the course or in the Clubhouse.
